Private House - McCrackin Street Essendon VIC

Essendon is an inner suburb of Melbourne, located approximately 8 kilometres northeast of the Central Business District. It lies within the City of Moonee Valley local government area. The suburb takes its name from the village of Essendon in Hertfordshire, England. Settlement began in the 1850s, when development in the Moonee Ponds district first commenced.

Project Design Brief

The designers of this home were tasked by the client with finding a discreet drainage solution that would seamlessly integrate with the large-format tiles chosen for the pool area. Collaborating with the builder, ACO developed a stainless steel tile insert drainage system specifically designed to perform effectively in an external environment.

- **BalconyDrain** with Tile grates

Benefits

- Tile grates ensure the secure fixing of the tiles with a continuous drainage slot around the perimeter.
- The V-shaped channel aids water flow to the plumbing outlets.
